## MINUTES

The White Hall City Council met for a regular meeting on April 20, 2015 at White Hall City Hall at 6:00 pm. In attendance were Council Members David Beck, Joel Foster, Scott Ray, Andy Lunsford, Beaver Johnson, City Attorney Tom Owens, City Clerk/Treasurer Ellen Welch, and Mayor Noel Foster. Council Member Ken Smith was absent.

Mayor Foster called the meeting to order.

Council Member Beaver Johnson gave the Invocation and Scott Ray led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Council Member Scott Ray to approve the March 16, 2015 Minutes as given. Council Member Joel Foster seconded the motion and the motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Foster welcomed the visitors in the audience and then made the following comments:

1. The 12<sup>th</sup> Annual "Kids Fest" will be held in the White Hall City Park on Friday, April 24<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, April 25<sup>th</sup>. It is a two-day event this year.
2. The James "Jitters" Morgan White Hall Community Center will have an "OPEN HOUSE" - Tuesday, April 21st from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. There will be a ribbon cutting and flag raising ceremony at 4:30 p.m.
3. The White Hall High School Class of 2015 will hold their graduation ceremony on Thursday, May 21, 2015 at 6:00 pm at the Pine Bluff Convention Center. The White Hall Police Department will provide security for the event.
4. Council Member Scott Ray announced that Opening Ceremonies for baseball will be this Saturday, April 25, 2015 at 4:00 pm.

There was one visitor's comment. Police Chief Rickey Wingard informed the council that Officer Brian Hornsby saved a woman's life by administering the Heimlich maneuver as she choked on her food at Mazzio's. The Police Department has been established for 33 years and Officer Brian Hornsby is the first to receive this "Life Saving Award". Officer Hornsby is receiving this award for his quick response to the situation, and displaying the kind of compassion and caring that makes us all proud of our Police Department.

### Reports


