MINUTES

The White Hall City Council met for a regular meeting on June 15, 2015 at White Hall City Hall at 6:00 pm. In attendance were Council Members Ken Smith, Joel Foster, Scott Ray, Beaver Johnson, David Beck, Andy Lunsford, City Clerk/Treasurer Ellen Welch, and Mayor Noel Foster. City Attorney Tom Owens was absent.

Mayor Foster called the meeting to order.

Council Member Andy Lunsford gave the Invocation and Council Member Scott Ray led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Council Member Andy Lunsford to approve the May 19, 2015 Minutes as given. Council Member Ken Smith seconded the motion and the motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Foster welcomed the visitors in the audience and then made the following comments:

1. Crenshaw Springs Water Park opened seven days a week on Saturday, June 13, 2015 at 11:00 am. Both the Water Park and community center have been busy.
2. It was an honor to host the Texas 4000, a group of about 30 University of Texas students who are cycling 4000 miles for cancer awareness. They are traveling all the way from Texas to Alaska, and included White Hall as one of their stops for rest. We thoroughly enjoyed sharing our community center with them for a night of rest before they continue northward.
3. The City of White Hall will hold the Alva Domon Fireworks Display at the White Hall High School Football field on Friday, July 4, 2015 at dark. This is made possible from donations from local area businesses. We do ask that you bring a canned food item for our food pantry.
4. White Hall Chamber of Commerce will hold their annual "Summer Cool Down" at Crenshaw Springs Water Park on Tuesday, July 14, 2015 from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm. Each chamber member, spouse, children and two guests are invited. Please call City Hall and give the names of family members and guests so we can make a list. We will have hamburgers, chips and drinks. This is one way for the Chamber to give back to the members. Bring the whole family and have a great time.

There was one visitor to comment. Police Chief Ricky Wingard informed the council that he had received a postcard and pictures from a couple whose vehicle had broken down on the I-530. Officers Harbison and Rogers helped the couple that was on their way to get married. It is always nice to get a "Thank You" card and recognition for a job well done.

Mayor Foster discussed with the council the Community Center being busier than anticipated and the need to hire additional staff. The Community Center has the funding available. A motion was made by Council Member Ken Smith to approve the hiring of one additional employee for the Community Center. Council Member Beaver Johnson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.




