The White Hall City Council met for a regular meeting on July 20, 2015 at White Hall City Hall at 6:00 pm. In attendance were Council Members Ken Smith, Scott Ray, Beaver Johnson, David Beck, Andy Lunsford, City Attorney Tom Owens, and Mayor Noel Foster. Council Member Joel Foster and City Clerk/Treasurer Ellen Welch were absent.

Mayor Foster called the meeting to order.

Council Member Beaver Johnson gave the Invocation and Council Member Ken Smith led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Council Member Ken Smith to approve the June 15, 2015 Minutes as given. Council Member Andy Lunsford seconded the motion and the motion carried 5-0.


